In 2005, David Bland was killed at his workplace by a former client. David worked as a Vocational Rehabilitation Counsellor at Richmond Mental Health. His tragic death served as a somber reminder that more needs doing to prevent incidents of violence in the workplace and to protect health and social services workers on the job. To honour David, and to recognize the efforts of health and safety advocates, the HSA Board of Directors established the David Bland Memorial Award.

- has taken initiative on a specific local issue in order to improve the health and safety of HSA members at their workplace?
