HSA members urged to participate in consultation to improve services for people with disabilities

The BC Ministry of Social Development and Social Innovation is coordinating a consultation to determine how to remove barriers and increase accessibility for people with disabilities in British Columbia.

The process includes a series of in-person community consultation sessions around the province scheduled from January 20 to the end of February. Dates, locations and times are listed [here](#).

Members can go to this site to learn more about the consultation process, to register to participate in an in-person consultation session in your community, and to submit your ideas using the online form until March 11. Input from this consultation will form the basis for a white paper that will be shared at a provincial summit in June 2014.
