- FACT:** As a share of the economy, B.C. government health spending is about seven cents on the dollar, the same as in 1991.
- FACT:** In terms of provincial government per capita spending on health care, B.C. has slipped from 2nd to 6th place between 2001 and 2006.
- FACT:** Based on the government's own numbers, in 2017, our investment in health care will be around the same portion of the provincial budget as it is today – about 40 per cent.
