# Last call for HSA Election Campaign School

Space is still available in HSA's 2-day, non-partisan election campaign school. This will be the last campaign school offered by HSA before the May 2013 provincial election, so members planning to work on this election are encouraged to apply.

This workshop is designed for members with little or no experience in electoral politics, but who are interested in working on election campaigns or running for political office. The school will focus on opportunities for involvement in the upcoming provincial election, but will also touch on municipal and federal elections.

If you want to help elect representatives who will support public health care and community social services, then HSA's election campaign school is for you!

Participants will discuss the various roles that HSA members can play during the pre-election and election periods. Workshop topics include:
